**Sunday – Arriving at Grand Session**

- Since some of us have several hours of travel to get to Grand Session, you will be permitted to arrive at Grand Session in slacks (dress pants or khakis), jeans (without holes or tears), shorts (length must be mid-thigh or longer), capris, dress, or skirt/blouse.
- As soon as you check into your rooms, you are to change into a skirt/blouse or dress.
- You are not permitted to walk around in the hotel in any type of pants unless specified in the program book.
- If you go to the pool area, you are required to wear shoes and an appropriate cover-up over your swimsuit.
